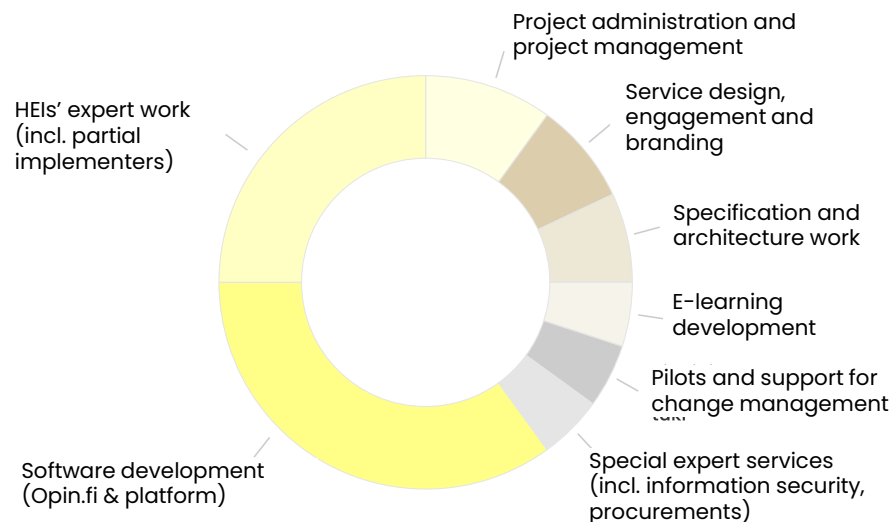


Digivisio's first phase brought a digital leap to higher education

– Opin.fi displays open studies on a single site

First phase (2021–2025) of Digivisio 2030, a joint project of the Finnish higher education institutions, created a national digital information platform, advanced cooperation between higher education institutions and made it easier for learners to find, browse and compare suitable studies. This way, the first phase digitalised continuous learning and laid a foundation for the renewal of the entire higher education sector.

Key results

Digital service platform and interoperability:

Foundation for the higher education institutions' joint digital services. Interoperability (HEDS/HEDI API standards) improves information flows and the use of data.

Opin.fi service:

Displays the open studies of 37 higher education institutions. Launched in 2025; 380,000 visits and 26,000 registration clicks by the end of 2025. Makes finding and comparing studies easier.

Learner-centric approach and e-learning:

Improved teaching staff's digital skills and promoted high-quality, accessible teaching.

Broad cooperation and support for change:

Created a new kind of cooperation culture and operating methods as well as steering structures between 37 HEIs.

Impacts and benefits

For learners:

Makes finding, browsing and comparing suitable studies easier, supports lifelong learning and individual learning paths.

For higher education institutions:

Better digital capabilities, resource efficiency, improved knowledge-based management and a stronger culture of cooperation.

For society:

Higher skills levels, smoother transitions to the labour market, wider accessibility of higher education.

Towards the future: Next phase of Digivisio

The first phase laid a solid foundation for the next phase of Digivisio. Phase 2 of the project (H2 2025–2027) will focus on the digital transformation of degree studies. The goal is to upgrade Virta study information service, expand Opin.fi service (incl. the study voucher) and increase the flexibility of degree studies.
